ABM Special Interest Group (SIG) Policies & Procedures

- 1. Member Recruitment and Advertising
 - a. Only ABM members are permitted to participate in SIGs, with the exception of:
 - i. The Annual International Meeting, where nonmembers can attend and get acquainted with the group.
 - ii. If the activity or event is fulfilling an ABM annual deliverable requirement that has been specifically advertised to non-members.
 - b. SIGs will have their own MyABM page
 - c. Groups may not establish exclusionary criteria for membership in a SIG

Annual deliverables for each SIG:

- 1. Two outreach items to be accessed by all ABM members and possibly by non-members (small fee for non-member attendees). Examples include:
 - a. Hosting a coffee chat
 - b. Webinar
 - c. Blog or newsletter article (consider publication in multiple languages)
 - d. SIGs are not allowed to start social media accounts or pages on the SIG's behalf, as this is a members-only benefit.
- 2. Brief Board report for annual meeting submitted to SIG Oversight Chair prior to Annual Meeting to be shared during Board Meeting

Proposing the creation of a new SIG:

- 1. Criteria: interest area must fall within the scope of the Academy of Breastfeeding Medicine and the focus does not overlap an area covered by an existing SIG
- 2. Two founding members should agree to be responsible for the formation of the SIG and must be current ABM members. The two founding members will serve as the inaugural co-chairs if the proposed SIG is approved
- 3. Written proposal must be submitted to SIG oversight chair at <u>abm@bfmed.org</u> and should include name of the group, contact information, and proposed leadership
 - a. This proposal will provide the SIG statement, detail the current need for the SIG, and describe the initial proposed goals and benefits to the ABM community
 - b. Five (5) current ABM members representing at least 2 separate institutions must support the creation of a new SIG and commit to being a member of the proposed SIG
- 4. New SIG creation will be confirmed by the ABM Board of Directors
 - a. The new SIG should plan to host the initial meeting within three months of approval
